

Bucuti Beach Resort Aruba ★★ *Finds* At little three-story Bucuti, you get personal service, European charm, and lush landscaping on a lovely 6-hectare (15-acre) stretch of one of the Caribbean's best beaches, the most secluded part of Eagle Beach. What this hotel has that those above don't is intimacy, a personal approach to inn keeping, and a sense of seclusion. It's a top choice for honeymooners. Each spacious, well-furnished, bright bedroom is on the beach and has two queen-size beds or one king-size bed and sleeper sofa. The most expensive units have two queen-size beds and an oceanfront balcony or terrace. The oceanfront Tara Wing, with beautiful, elegant bedrooms and a first-class spa, opened in 2004. All rooms have well-maintained bathrooms with tub/shower combos.

Across from the Alhambra Bazaar and Casino, the hotel operates the oceanfront Pirates' Nest Restaurant, a replica of a 17th-century Dutch galleon that specializes in good steaks, fresh seafood, and theme nights.
