

11 Must-Visit Adults-Only Hotels in the Caribbean

It seems like a new all-inclusive resort pops up every week in the Caribbean, and it's true that the vast majority of adults-only resorts in the islands follow a pay-one-price model for rooms, activities, and dining.

But it's not a recipe that works for every couple. All-inclusives tend to be larger hotels, for example, and while most offer a wide variety of options for food and fun, some couples prefer a more intimate vacation experience and the freedom to get off the resort and dine and play locally. Bucuti and Tara is small by Aruba standards, with just 45 suites and 59 hotel rooms, but offers an extensive wellness program and a variety of romantic experiences for couples.
